## All Students will need the following supplies:

- 1 inch 3-Ring Binder to be left in the music room
- Spiral Bound SINGLE-subject notebook
- At least one sharpened pencil to write in music and complete assignments.


## Concert Attendance/Attire:

Students are required to be in attendance at all concerts. Students will need to report to the choir room 15 minutes before the start of the concert for warm-up. Concerts are worth 400 points each. Should you be absent from a concert for whatever reason, a make-up assignment will be assigned. Students are required to stay for the entire concert. This means they will be present for the band portion. To achieve the entire 400 grade points, attendance for the performance is required.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for concert performances and adhere to the school dress code. Nice dress shirts and dress pants are great for boys. Ties are not required, but look very professional! Skirts and dresses are also acceptable, but please consider appropriate length. No rubber flip-flops and no jeans please. Cell phones do not need to be visible during a concert performance.

## Grading Procedures:

My goal is to provide your kids with the knowledge to have a lifelong appreciation for music. They will have the skills to continue performing should they choose to do so. The grade received in this class will reflect progress as a musician and a responsible student. Grades are based on the use of Formative Assessments 20\% (rehearsal skills, written work, and quizzes), and Summative Assessments $80 \%$ (tests, concert attendance and performance).

Rehearsal Skills will be graded daily, but will only be entered once a month. Students must:

- be in their assigned seat with materials when the bell rings or within the time frame announced. Class will start one minute after the bell rings.
- have a pencil in their possession
- have all assigned music
- no gum or candy, water bottles that seal are acceptable

Written Work will be assigned every week and will be completed during class time. Quizzes will be given every other week.

- bell work assignments - will introduce and review vocabulary, a complete vocabulary list will be given to each student
- written music theory quizzes - test the definable aspects of music that will be covered in class.
- written response to listening - It is important that students are exposed to many different genres of music. Students will simply listen to a piece of music and then respond appropriately in writing.
- written performance summaries/critiques - allows students to apply those definable aspects and use the vocabulary in context.


## Concert Review Guidelines -- should you be absent from a concert

- Students are writing about their favorite or not so favorite performing group.
- Review must be two pages, typed, double space
- Include the following information about your choice of group: Who, When, Where, What (music they play), do you enjoy their music or not, and why you do or do not enjoy their music. Do these performers adhere to the musicianship skills you have been working to develop?
- Research should include information on specific songs and biographical pieces as well. Biographical information could include family, education, etc.
- Use more than one source. More than one website is acceptable. Please list these sources at the end of your review. Due one week following the performance or can be turned in prior to absence.

This assignment is the only way to make-up the points missed for being absent from a concert. The assignment needs to be completed in its entirety in order to receive the full 400 concert points.
